PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2018**

This Order is made by Carmarthenshire County Council ("the Authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath described in Paragraph 1 of this Order, and of the public, it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

Mrs Elizabeth Ryves-Brown of Ty Cwar, Cilycwm, Llandovery, Carmarthenshire has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

Llansadwrn Community Council has been consulted on the making of the Order as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER

1. The public right of way over the land situated at Graig Beynon, Llansadwrn, Carmarthenshire, and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up after 14 days from the date of confirmation of this Order.
2. There shall, at the end of 14 days from the date of confirmation of this Order be a public footpath over the land situated at Graig Beynon, Llansadwrn, Carmarthenshire, as described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this Order.
3. Notwithstanding this Order, any statutory undertaker having apparatus affected by this Order shall have the following rights over the land referred to in Paragraph 1 namely: access at all reasonable times to maintain or repair statutory apparatus.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

Commencing from a point approximately 75 metres west of Graig Beynon at SN69323448 (being Point 'A' on the Order Map) the footpath heads in an easterly direction along a field track to the south of the field boundary immediately adjacent to Graig Beynon house (Point 'B'). From here, the path heads around the buildings in a south-easterly direction descending through the garden before crossing the property boundary to terminate in the north-eastern corner of the field at SN69473445 (being Point 'C' on the Order Map)

Length – 177 metres
Width – undefined

PART 2

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

Commencing from a point approximately 75 metres west of Graig Beynon at SN69323448 (being Point 'A' on the Order Map) the new route heads gradually downhill in an east-south-easterly direction to the eastern corner of the field before passing through an opening into the next field. From here, the footpath heads in an easterly direction following the south side of the property boundary to rejoin the original footpath in the north-eastern corner of the field at SN69473445 (being Point 'C' on the Order Map).

Length – 152 metres
Width – 2 metres

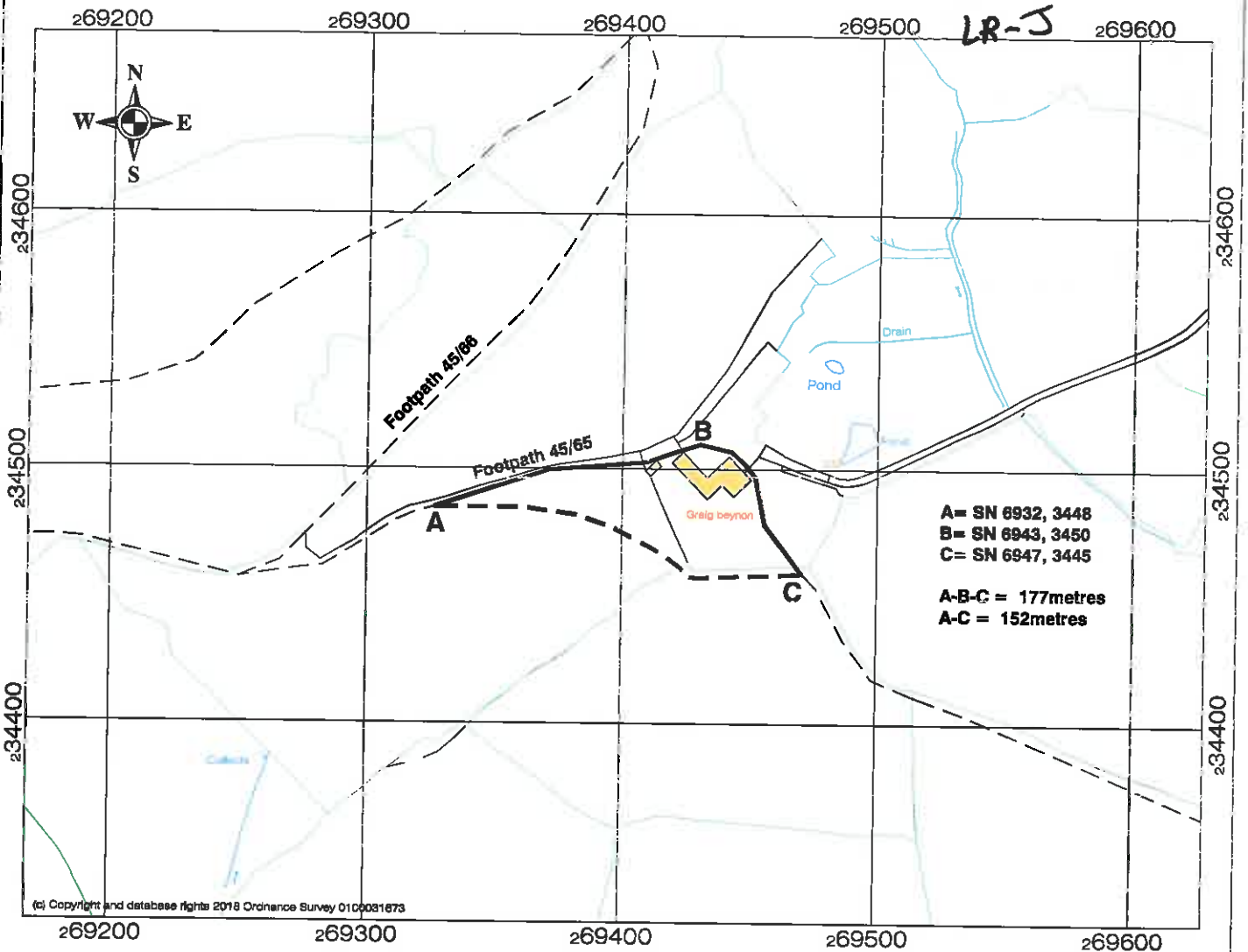
