6. All animals to be led and no animals shall be allowed in the show ground unless properly haltered.
7. All Livestock Vehicles will be admitted to the field free of charge including the driver.
8. All Horses to remain in designated areas unless competing in Show Ring.
9. Sheep to be entered before unloading.
10. Entries not to be moved from the marquee until 4.00 p.m.
11. The Committee reserves the right to inspect the garden of any competitor should the need arise.
12. In the event of a tie, where a cup is awarded for the highest number of points in a section, the winner will be decided by the highest number of first prize points. In the event of a further tie a toss of a coin will decide the result.
13. The taking of photographs within the show ground is strictly forbidden, except by authorized operators or by individuals for private purposes.
14. DEFRA rules are to be observed.
15. No bicycles allowed on the Show Field.





Flap-Jacks

Ingredients: -

250g Butter

115g Soft Brown Sugar

2 x Tablespoons Golden Syrup

340g Rolled Oats

115g Plain Flour

Method: -

1. In a Medium/large saucepan, melt butter, brown sugar and syrup. Simmer until sugar has melted. Do not boil.
2. Add oats and flour. Mix well.
3. Line a square or a rectangle tin with parchment paper then pour mixture into tin. Even out with the back of a spoon. Watch as it will be hot!
