3. Exhibits in all sections to be the bona-fide property of the exhibitor for one month prior to the Show. This rule will be strictly enforced.
4. Any objections to be made in writing and lodged with the Secretary within 20 minutes after judging has ended in that class, with a deposit of £5. The Show Officials decision thereon will be final and, if the objection is not upheld, the deposit will be forfeited. The Committee reserves the right to have any horse measured.
5. All exhibits to be on Show Field not later than 30 minutes before judging of their class.
6. All animals to be led and no animals shall be allowed in the show ground unless properly haltered.
7. All Livestock Vehicles will be admitted to the field free of charge including the driver.
8. All Horses to remain in designated areas unless competing in Show Ring.
9. Sheep to be entered before unloading.
10. Entries not to be moved from the marquee until 4.00 p.m.
11. The Committee reserves the right to inspect the garden of any competitor should the need arise.
12. In the event of a tie, where a cup is awarded for the highest number of points in a section, the winner will be decided by the highest number of first prize points. In the event of a further tie a toss of a coin will decide the result.
13. The taking of photographs within the show ground is strictly forbidden, except by authorized operators or by individuals for private purposes.
14. DEFRA rules are to be observed.
15. No bicycles allowed on the Show Field.

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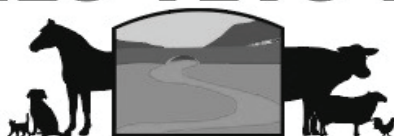
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Judge's Recipe 2026

Yummy Scrummy Carrot Cake

Ingredients :-

175g (6oz) Light Brown Sugar
175ml (6fl oz) Sunflower Oil
3 Large Eggs Lightly Beaten
140g (5oz) Grated Carrot (about 3 medium carrots)
100g (4oz) Raisins
175g (6oz) Self-raising Flour
1 teaspoon Bicarbonate of Soda
½ teaspoon Nutmeg
1 teaspoon Ground Cinnamon
Zest of 1 Large Orange.

For the Frosting :-

175g (6oz) Icing Sugar
1 ½ - 2 tablespoons of Orange Juice

Method :-

Preheat oven to 180c/gas 4/fan oven 160c.
Line sides and base of 7" square or round tin.

Put sugar in a large bowl with oil and eggs.
Lightly mix, stir in grated carrot, raisins and zest of orange.
Mix flour with bicarbonate of soda and nutmeg and sift into a bowl.
Lightly mix all ingredients together.

Pour mixture into prepared tin and bake for 40-45 minutes until it feels firm and springy when you press it in the centre.
Cool in tin for 5 mins before turning it out onto wire tray to cool.

Method for frosting :-

Beat together the frosting ingredients in a small bowl until smooth.
Drizzle icing over the top.
